MARY JEAN FEHRING DAVINI OAKLEY was born September 20, 1942 in Terre Haute, to Ted and Marie. She was healthy and active, pleasant and popular, as she went through the local schools, then studied Home Economics at Chico State for three years.

Jean married **DAVID ANDREW DAVINI, JR.** June 16, 1962 in Carmel's Church of the Wayfarer. During finals her junior year, May 23, 1963, she gave birth to **DEBORAH (DEBBIE) JEAN** in Chico. The family moved to Yuba City where David taught business education in high school. He had received his B.S. and M.S. in this field, and later served as administrator and president of the regional occupation program.

After **ANDREA LYNNE** was born July 31, 1964 Jean was a substitute teacher for six years, then taught in the 'Head Start' program. **THEODORE ('TED') EDWARD** was also born in Yuba City March 6, 1969. He was active in soccer, golf and Boy Scouts, winning honors as Eagle Scout and 'Order of the Arrow'. Each summer, he helps others at a camp in the Sierra Nevada mountains. He was a delegate to Boys' State, attended Yuba College, and will major in Civil Engineering at the University of California in Sacramento, in 1989.
